# THE “RUBÉN BONIFAZ NUÑO” AWARD FOR UNIVERSITY PUBLISHING

The International Book Fair for University Students (Filuni) of the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM), dean of the Mexican university presses, awards every year a distinction to the exceptional trajectory of a university publisher in Ibero-America. The Award for University Publishing was named “Rubén Bonifaz Nuño” to honor the imprint left by the great teacher and creator, whose legacy of passion for the written word and publishing culture continues to serve as an example and a guide at UNAM.

**The seventh edition of the Award will observe the following guidelines:**

1. Nominations may be submitted by any institution, publishing house, association, individual or legal entity linked to the university book industry.
2. Only one person can be nominated per submission.
3. Nominations must be addressed to the Jury of the “Rubén Bonifaz Nuño” Award. Submission may be sent either to Avenida del IMAN 5 Ciudad Universitaria, Coyoacán, C.P. 04510, Mexico City, or electronically in pdf format through the link [bit.ly/3BI7Tph](https://bit.ly/3BI7Tph)
4. In no more than two pages, nominations must include the full name of the nominating institution, publishing house, association, or individual; the full name of the nominee; the reasons for the nomination, and short bio of the nominee.
5. Only living individuals who have made or are making a significant contribution to the university publishing world in their own country or abroad are eligible. They may be in office or in retirement.
6. Neither personnel of the Directorate of Publications and Editorial Promotion, not anyone with a professional link with this university department, may be nominated for the “Rubén Bonifaz Nuño” Award.
7. Previous winners of the Award may not be nominated.
8. Self-nominations are not permitted.
9. This Call for Nominations will remain open until 11:59 p.m. Central Time on 9 May 2025,
10. Nominations will be reviewed by an international jury of experts in the publishing and academic world selected by the Directorate of Publications and Editorial Promotion. The names of the juries will be announced together with the results. The decision of the jury is final and indisputable.
11. The results will be announced on Thursday 12 June 2025.
12. The winner will receive a silver coin and a diploma during the 7<sup>th</sup> Edition of Filuni, that will be held from Tuesday 26 August through Sunday 31 August 2025 in Mexico City. If the award winner does not live in Mexico City, their transportation and lodging expenses will be covered by Filuni.
13. All cases that are not foreseen in this Call for Nominations or any issue that may arise during the process will be resolved by the Directorate of Publications and Publishing Promotion, in accordance with UNAM’s Code of Ethics and any other applicable regulation.
14. All personal data collected will be protected, incorporated, and processed in accordance with applicable regulations and solely for the purposes of this Call for Nominations.
